## JULY EXPERIENCE (8 DAYS / 7 NIGHTS)

A scenic journey through the Rift Valley, central highlands, and the iconic Maasai Mara from USD 3,124 per person sharing and USD 4,537 for solo traveler





### Day 1: Arrival – Lake Naivasha

Accommodation: Lake Naivasha Resort (or similar)  
Upon arrival, depart from Nairobi to Lake Naivasha, a beautiful freshwater lake set in the Great Rift Valley.

Arrive at your resort and enjoy a relaxed afternoon surrounded by lush greenery and abundant birdlife.

Optional activities at a Fee include a boat safari to spot hippos and fish eagles or a guided walking safari at Crescent Island, where you can walk among giraffes, zebras, and antelope.  
Dinner and overnight at the resort.

### Day 2: Lake Naivasha – Nanyuki (Mount Kenya Region)

Accommodation: Nanyuki Lodge/Resort  
After breakfast, travel to the central highlands, arriving in Nanyuki at the foothills of Mount Kenya, the tallest mountain in Kenya.

Check in at your lodge for lunch, set in a serene environment with views of Africa's second-highest mountain.

Spend the afternoon at leisure or enjoy optional activities such as horseback riding, nature walks, or visiting a nearby conservancy.  
Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

### Day 3: Nanyuki – Leisure & Exploration

Accommodation: Nanyuki Lodge/Resort (or similar)

Enjoy a full day in Ol Pejeta Conservancy, as a world-renowned wildlife sanctuary located on the Laikipia Plateau. It is famously home to the world's last two northern white rhinos and serves as the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. This day offers a refreshing contrast to the safari plains ahead.

Dinner and overnight.



#### Day 4: Nanyuki – Lake Nakuru National Park

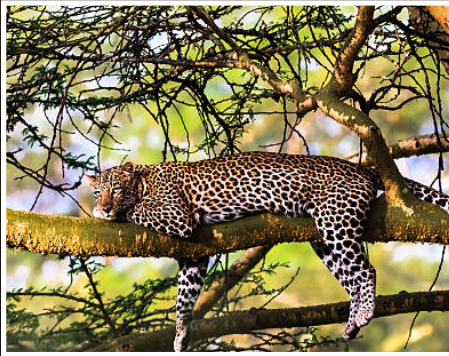
Accommodation: Lake Nakuru Lodge / Sopa Lodge (or similar)

After breakfast, journey back into the Great Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru National Park, known for its diverse species of birds & flamingos, Tree climbing lions and breath taking baboon cliff lookout and Makalia waterfall

Arrive at your lodge overlooking the lake and enjoy lunch before heading out for an afternoon game drive.

The park is a renowned rhino sanctuary and home to Rothschild giraffes, lions, buffalo, and diverse birdlife including flamingos.

Dinner and overnight at the lodge.



#### Day 5: Lake Nakuru – Maasai Mara National Reserve

Accommodation: Safari Camp/Lodge in Maasai Mara (or similar)

After breakfast, depart Maasai Mara, globally famous for its vast savannahs and incredible density of big cats. It offers safari experience and serves as the stage for one of nature's greatest spectacles

Arrive in time for lunch, followed by an afternoon game drive across the expansive savannah.

On this day you can have an option of visiting the Maasai village and experience how the Maasai people live and know more about their culture.

Dinner and overnight at your camp/lodge.

#### Day 6: Maasai Mara – Full Day Safari

Accommodation: Safari Camp/Lodge in Maasai Mara

Spend a full day exploring the Maasai Mara with morning and afternoon game drives.

Track the Big Five and observe the dynamic interactions between predators and prey especially the wildebeest at Sand River for dramatic crocodile-infested crossings during the migration season.

Optional experiences include a hot air balloon safari at sunrise or a visit to a Maasai village for cultural insights.

Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.





### Day 7: Maasai Mara – Extended Safari

Accommodation: Safari Camp/Lodge in Maasai Mara

Another full day in the Mara allows deeper exploration of different of the reserve, including river areas where dramatic migration crossings may occur.

This extended stay increases your chances of witnessing some of Africa's most iconic wildlife moments.

Dinner and overnight at the camp/lodge.

### Day 8: Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip or depart by road back to Nairobi for your onward flight, marking the end of your unforgettable Kenya safari.
